recipes. Linda was talented with crocheting hats and blankets that she would gift family and friends. And she spent countless hours reading books and newspapers. She had an uncanny ability to locate anything and everything in her packed refrigerator, and had a habit of buying multiples of the same item. Linda cherished time with her family, most of all. Through the years it was taking Daniel fishing at the river, attending Tracy's dance recitals, her yearly trip to Branson with her sister, Sharon, or dinner at Red Lobster, and a movie or trip to the casino with Dennis, she always wanted to be with her family. She especially cherished time with her two granddaughters, and had made it her goal to see her second granddaughter born as she continued to battle her cancer; a goal which she achieved. Linda will be remembered for always putting other's needs above her own.

Linda passed away on Saturday, December 11, 2021 at the Josie Harper Hospice House in Omaha, Nebraska after a battle with cancer at the age of 63 years, 8 months, and 3 days.
