On any given day, as soon as you entered the house you were greeted with a big smile and a loving hug.

As a proud breast cancer survivor, Linda was an advocate and inspired many women with breast cancer by her determined spirit and positive attitude. Linda was also one of the founding members of the "Lunch Bunch", a group that has been bringing women together for food and fun for over 27 years. She was a mother figure, friend, a voice of reason in times of uncertainty, comedian, and the political advocate within the group. Linda loved being with and supporting others and enjoyed seeing everyone have a good time. Whatever the occasion, you could guarantee Linda was laughing and making others laugh. She made everything more fun, and yes a bit rowdier. Linda was not just the life of the party and a person everyone wanted to be around, she was also the LOVE of every party. Her grandkids would giggle at how she named them, for example she had gold kitty, white kitty, and black kitty. Linda gave every animal the most loving home they could desire. 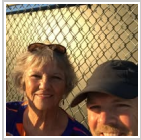
