Louis John Czarnick was born on March 15, 1924 in Genoa, Nebraska to Joe and Ellen (Foreman) Czarnick. He grew up on the family farm south of Genoa and attended Krackow Catholic School through the 8th grade. Family hardships caused Louie to devote much of his time to running the family farm but he did enjoy playing baseball.

Louie married Cecelia Ksiazek on September 25, 1950 at Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Clarks, Nebraska and they were blessed with three children: Paulette, Ken and Mary. Louie and Cecelia raised their family in Clarks and Omaha before moving to Valley in 1967.

Louie farmed and worked for Union Pacific Railroad before becoming a carpenter and working in construction. He was creative and could make almost anything out of wood. Louie loved fishing and the time he could spend with his family. He was known far and wide for his "homemade pies". Louie enjoyed simple things especially summertime comfort food – fried chicken, sweet corn and potato salad and wash it down with a cold beer. He was a man of his word and expected you to do the same.

Louie passed away on Saturday, August 10, 2013 in Valley, Nebraska at the age of 89 years, 4 months and 26 days.
