



Margaret Emma Bull

February 14, 1930 - April 25, 2026

The youngest of nine children, Margaret Emma Betts was born on February 14, 1930, at home on the Betts family farm, which is now the site of Elkhorn North High School. She received her education from Elkhorn Public Schools, graduating with the class of 1947. On June 22, 1949, Margaret married Gordon John Bull at Bethany Lutheran Church in Elkhorn, and they were blessed with three children: Barbara, Danny and David. Margaret remained a faithful and devoted servant of Bethany until her death on April 25, 2026. She was even celebrated as the longest living member at Bethany's 100-year celebration in September 2025.

Early in their marriage, Margaret and Gordy owned Elkhorn Hardware Store. "Maggie" kept the books and worked at being a "stay-at-home" mom. In 1971, she took a job with the Elkhorn Post Office sorting mail and working the window. After 21 years of service, Margaret retired in 1992.

Margaret always liked playing cards, traveling, and working jigsaw puzzles. She loved to bake and was known for her zucchini bread, banana bread, cookies and scrabble. As a grandma, Grandma Great doted on her eight grandchildren and twenty great-grandchildren. In her later years, Margaret enjoyed her book club friends and lunch bunch.

Margaret was preceded in death by her husband Gordon, son Danny, and

grandson Nicholas. Survivors include Barbara (Lynn) Spilman of Vero Beach, FL and son David (Kathy) Bull of Elkhorn, NE; grandchildren: Katie (David) Barker, Jeremy (Samantha) Spilman, Jeff Bull, Jamey (Kelli) Bull, Erin (Donn) Kasner, Kari (Mike) Winklepleck, and Abby (Chris) Sayers; and great-grandchildren: Gracie, Lucy, and Wilson Barker; Isla Spilman; Leilani Bull; Reese, Riley and Lauren Bull; Kamryn, Jack, and Keegan Kasner; Brinley, Paysen, Landrey, and Kelton Winklepleck; and River, Riggs, Nixon, Navy, and Briar Sayers.
