Margaret Ann Kohlhaase, age 94, passed away peacefully at Marquis Place in Elkhorn, Nebraska, on December 31, 2024. She was born on October 25, 1930, in Omaha, Nebraska, to John and Elizabeth (Barna) Bennett. Margaret was the youngest of 11 children and graduated from Omaha North High School.

Margaret loved volunteering as a poll worker during elections, playing bingo and making occasional trips to the casino.

In October 2024, Margaret joyfully celebrated her 94th birthday surrounded by her children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren. It was a day full of love and laughter.
