Marie Evelyn (Shultz) Sivertson was born at home in Brayton, NE on January 3, 1927 to James and Tracy (Kalberg) Shultz. She was the third youngest of ten children. She graduated from the 10th grade and then went to live with an older sister in Wyoming. Marie received her GED in 1968, of which she was extremely proud.

On April 22, 1946, Marie married Gordon Wayne Becker. Their union was blessed with three children: Connie (Tom) of Oaklan, NE, Carol of Omaha, NE, and Gary (Dana) of Georgetown, Tx; 8 grandchildren; 18 great grandchildren; and 6 great great grandchildren. Marie was known by her great great grandchildren as "Triple G".

On September 4, 1976, she married Leslie Sivertson and they were together until his passing in 2014. This union gained Marie her three stepchildren: Ron (Karen) of Topeka, KS, Rich of Omaha, NE and Lori (Mark) of Bedford, TX. She also gained another 9 grandchildren and 18 great grandchildren.

Marie was a long-time member of Church of Christ, Waterloo (now The Tabernacle). She was baptized there on July 3, 1970. She loved to shop and especially enjoyed going to garage sales and thrift stores. She was well known for her homemade banana bread. Every day, Marie talked with her long-time friend, Dee Thompson, of Fremont, NE. She did this until just a few

days prior to her death on December 29, 2025. Marie was a very strong and determined lady. She will be missed by many, and her family was so blessed to have her in their lives for all these years.
