Mary Ann D. (Miller) Simons was born October 28, 1925 on the family farm between Ashland and Yutan to Frederick and Lena (Heldt) Miller. Mary Ann grew up in the Ashland and Yutan area, where she attended District 7 School for grades 1-8, and graduated from Yutan High School in 1942. As a young girl, Mary Ann was active in sports, and was a talented musician; singing and playing both organ and accordion.
