



## Mary Kathryn Scott

August 2, 1920 - November 20, 2009

Mary Kathryn “M.K.” (Riley) Scott was born August 2, 1920 in Centralia, Missouri to Alexander and Willette Blanton (Sneed) Riley. The youngest of seven children, M.K. grew up in the country around Centralia. Her mother passed away while M.K. was only eight years old, and she lived with her Dad, older brother and sister for a few years, later with married sisters.

M.K. married Charles Scott on August 29, 1936 in Rockport, Missouri, and to this union, a daughter, Charlyn, was born. The family made their home in Missouri, before moving on to Virginia, California, Iowa, Colorado, and finally settled in Nebraska. Charles preceded M.K. in death in 1996.

M.K. worked a variety of jobs until she earned her LPN degree in 1959. Through the years, she has worked as a nurse at the University of Nebraska Medical Center, Douglas County Annex, and Montclair Nursing Home. M.K. also worked for the Elkhorn Middle School for a number of years after Charles passed, working in the cafeteria serving line. She served at the school until 3 or 4 years ago.

M.K. enjoyed going camping and fishing, traveling, gardening, yard work, sewing, reading and playing table games, and was a faithful member of Westside Church. She will be remembered as an independent, resourceful, sincere, loyal, and loving woman. M.K. had a deep and abiding faith in God,

and dearly loved her husband, daughter, and extended family and friends.

M.K. passed away on Friday, November 20, 2009 at the Montclair Nursing Home in Omaha, Nebraska at the age of 89 years, 3 months, and 18 days. She is preceded in death by her husband Charles. M.K. is survived by her daughter Charlyn Scott and nieces and nephews.
