Shelley grew up in Remsen, Iowa, and attended Remsen Union Schools. She had a horse named "Major Denney" and went to many competitions and won many trophies. She graduated from high school and attended a couple colleges, returned home, and enrolled in Bishop Clarkson School of Nursing. She graduated as an RN and was crowned Miss Clarkson. While attending a New Year's Eve party, she met Warren and stated, "that's the guy." Shelley and Warren were married for 48 and a half years, after they traveled down the Colorado River on their honeymoon.

She moved back to Iowa and worked as an RN and received a BA in Psychology at Westmar College in LeMars, Iowa. Shelley and Warren moved to Omaha, where she worked at many institutions. She obtained her BSN and worked on her Master's, until she ran into Orem's Law and said "enough". Years of work as an RN took its toll physically and mentally, and Shelley became disabled, and was diagnosed as Bipolar.

Shelley loved people. She would send flowers, cards, call you or come over and read from the Bible to you. She was on the Altar Guild at St. Timothy's Lutheran Church in Omaha for many years. Shelley was a great cook and homemaker.

Shelley passed away on April 4, 2024, at Methodist Hospital in Omaha. She was preceded in death by her parents Thelma & Fred Moeller, brother Alan Moeller, numerous other relatives and friends, her in-laws Leonard & Evelyn Wallin and her German Shepherds. Cherished to remember her are her husband Warren, brother Mark, his wife Tressa, and nephew Spencer Moeller, sister-in-law and brother-in-law Karen & Tom Riedemann, and "family" Stuart, Sharon and Ann Sysel and her current German Shepherd, Freya.
