



Milton James Sindelar

September 5, 1928 - October 4, 2020

Milton James Sindelar was born September 5, 1928 in St. Edward, Nebraska to Edward and Catherine “Katie” (Kurtenbach) Sindelar. The fourth of 9 children, and twin to a brother Maurice, Milton grew up on the family farm near St. Edward, and worked on the farm with his dad, while his brothers fought in WWII.

Milton met Sally Jewell at the age of 18, and they were married September 6, 1948, the day after his 20th birthday (they waited until that day, so Milton didn’t appear to be marrying an “older woman”). Milt and Sally were blessed with 7 children: Dan, Connie, Sue, Jane, Tammy, Sally, and Jim.

Milt started his career with Pepsi Cola, and Sealtest Ice Cream, where his brother Orville was his boss. He then spent 25 years as a General Manager for ITT Continental Baking Company in Omaha, Nebraska. He retired from ITT in 1983; but then, went to work for the next 14 years for Metz Baking Company in Sioux City, Iowa as Senior Vice President of Operations. Milton retired from Metz in 1997.

After his retirement, Milt and Sally moved to an acreage in Colon, Nebraska, where Milt enjoyed mowing and taking care of the property. In 2002, they sold the acreage, and moved to Elkhorn to be closer to their children, living in Elkhorn until 2017. They then moved into Elk Ridge Retirement Village in

2017. Milt loved being social with the other residents. He participated in the men's coffee group, attended weekly mass, and enjoyed the weekly happy hour.

Milton loved his dogs and was especially fond of taking them on walks. He had a sweet tooth and couldn't resist a cinnamon roll. Milton will be remembered as a very proud, hard-working man, and he passed his work ethic on to his children. He was grateful to be able to celebrate his 92nd birthday on September 5, 2020 and cherished his 72 years of marriage to Sally. His greatest love was for Sally and all his family.

Milton died Sunday, October 4, 2020 at Elk Ridge Retirement Village at the age of 92 years and 29 days. He was preceded in death by his parents Edward & Catherine "Katie" Sindelar, 2 sisters, and 5 brothers.
