Mitchell Dean Quandt was born on October 13, 1987 in Omaha, Nebraska to Mark and Meschele (Stidham) Quandt. He grew up in Lenexa, Kansas, attended Rising Star Elementary School, Westridge Middle School, and graduated from Shawnee Mission West High School in 2006. Mitch went on to attend and play baseball at Iowa Western and Labette County Community College where he earned an Associates Degree in Applied Sciences. As a young boy, Mitch enjoyed baseball, soccer, basketball, and spending time at the lake. By the age of 8, Mitch discovered his love for mowing lawns and landscaping, which continued throughout his life.

Mitch married the love of his life, Jancye Brooke Trost, on August 24, 2013 at the Bellevue Berry Farm and Pumpkin Patch in Bellevue, Nebraska. In 2015, Mitch and Jancye were blessed with twin boys, Calvin Mitchell and Cohen Dean, whom he loved dearly. Mitch and Jancye are expecting their third child in January 2019.

Professionally, Mitch began his career owning and operating Quandt Lawn & Landscape LLC. He later worked as a Minor League Baseball Umpire. Finally,

he found his calling as a truck driver for Storm Transport. He enjoyed an active life, sports, spending time with friends and family, and playing with his children. He was an avid fan of the Huskers and Baltimore Orioles, enjoyed country music, Mexican food, and an ice-cold Busch Light. Mitch was energetic, fun, generous, and hard-working. He lived everyday by his motto, "Keep grindin."

On Wednesday, May 30, 2018, Mitch was involved in a tragic accident on I-80 near Utica, Nebraska and suddenly passed away. He was only 30 years, 7 months and 17 days old. He is survived by his wife Jancye, twin boys Calvin Mitchell and Cohen Dean, parents Mark Quandt and Meschele Quandt, siblings Matthew Quandt and Megan Tilson, and grandparents Velma Quandt, George Stidham, and Theresa Holz.

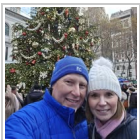
