Myra Frances Krahmer died on June 27, 2021 in Omaha, Nebraska. She was 78 years old. She was born in Hastings, Nebraska on July 10, 1942 to Harold Senstock and Frances (Boro) Senstock. Myra was the seventh of eight children and graduated from Hastings High School in 1960.

Myra married Herman Keith Krahmer on October 15, 1961 at St. John's Lutheran Church in Yutan, Nebraska. From this marriage five daughters were born: Danielle, Angeline, DeAnna, Analisa, Debralee.
