Myrtle Helen (Biel) Bartels, daughter of Gus and Hannah (Steen) Biel was born September 14, 1909 on the Biel farm Northwest of Millard. She was baptized and confirmed at the Evangelical Lutheran Church at Chalco, Nebraska in Sarpy County on April 13, 1924 by Rev. H. F. Schmidt. She attended Lane School and Oakdale School.

Myrtle became a member of St. Paul Lutheran Church of Millard in 1932 and on March 11, 1932 she married Arthur Bartels, a marriage that lasted over 51 years. They began their married life on the Bartels farm just east of Millard, which is now known as the "Oaks Addition". Three children were born while they were living on this farm: Corrine, Danny and Larry. Myrtle continued to live in her home until two months ago when she moved into assisted living at Lakeside Village.

In early years, Myrtle did a lot of babysitting for grandchildren and neighbor children which she loved doing. She enjoyed playing cards, especially "Sheepshead", and visiting. She also enjoyed being with her family. In years past, she had served as Secretary of the Ladies Aid Society of St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Treasurer of Bloomfield School District and President of Friendly Neighbors.

Myrtle passed away on Tuesday, September 25, 2007 at Lakeside Hospital in

Omaha at the age of 98 years and 11 days. She was preceded in death by her parents Gus and Hannah Biel, her husband Arthur in 1983, son and daughter-in-law Danny & Bev Bartels, brother Bernie Biel and sister Pearl Wagner.

Myrtle is survived by daughter Corrine and husband Mylan Kruse of Cedar Bluffs, Nebraska; son Larry Bartels and wife Gloria of Elkhorn, Nebraska; six grandchildren and ten great-grandchildren; sister Mable Melia of Gretna, Nebraska and nieces and nephews.
