Norman Floyd Seip was born on June 12, 1926 in Barnston, Nebraska to Arthur and Ethyl (Eckert) Seip. He grew up in Barnston where attended school. As a young boy, Norm would help with family chores around the farm and it was here that he learned to fix things.

Norm married Zella Headley on November 2, 1947 in Omaha, Nebraska and to this union five children were born: Larry, Mike, Patti, Kerri and Randy. Norm and Zella raised their family in Lincoln, Waterloo and Fremont.

He worked at Hormel from 1953 until his retirement in 1992 and then worked for Pinkerton as a security guard at the plant. Norm received his engineering degree at Omaha Tech and apprenticed at Clearview in Omaha. He enjoyed fixing small appliances, dancing with Zella, decorating for Halloween and travelling. Norm loved to tinker and kept detailed notes on many different subjects. He was fun loving and kind with an ornery streak. Norm enjoyed country music, rooting for the Huskers and dinner at El Bee's.
