Penny Nordahl was born December 7, 1938 in Brooklyn, New York to Henry and Frances (Ritter) Webb. Penny grew up on Long Island in New York, and graduated from Amityville High School in 1956. As a young girl, Penny was active in Ballet and Batton, and was a Girl Scout. She went on to earn her Bachelor's degree.

Penny married Carl E. Nordahl in October 1960, and to this union, two sons were born; Carl H. and Christopher. The family made their home in Omaha, Nebraska.

Penny worked for a number of years as an educator, and taught English and served as a grant administrator at the University of Nebraska in Omaha. She was active in a bowling league, and enjoyed puzzles, watching birds, reading, attending the theater and traveling. She had a great sense of humor, and loved corny jokes.

Penny will be remembered as a selfless, witty, creative, intelligent, and clever woman. Her favorite color was purple, and her favorite flower, the peony.
