Perry Gene Compton of Elkhorn, NE, passed away on Saturday, July 22, 2023, after several years of medical complications. Perry was born on December 28, 1947, in Watertown, SD, to Lucille lone and Joseph William Compton. Lucille passed away when Perry was eight years of age and after, he lived with various foster families. He graduated from Henry High School in 1966. He worked in Watertown, for about a year after graduating. In May of 1967, he enlisted in the Navy and completed basic training in San Diego, CA. Perry worked as a dental technician and had a tour of duty in Japan. In all, he served four years in the Navy. He remained in San Diego, while he worked and went to school. In 1976, he moved to Nebraska. Perry worked as a police officer in Elkhorn and graduated from the police academy in Grand Island in 1980. He also worked as police officer in Schuyler, NE. In 1999, he graduated with his bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice. He worked as a car salesman and various other jobs around the country. He was eventually placed on disability due service-related injury and declining health.

Perry enjoyed playing his guitar and singing songs by John Denver, Simon and Garfunkel, and Cat Stevens. He found a love for painting that he learned by watching Bob Ross. He liked to cook and could literally make something out of leftover contents in his refrigerator. He had a love of animals and had several dogs and cats over the years. He collected model cars and loved to watch movies.

Though Perry missed years with his children, he did his best to restore his

relationships with them and he enjoyed spending time with his grandchildren. Perry is preceded in death by Lucille and Joseph Compton (parents), Bobby Ward (brother), Al Ward (brother), Sandra Lekvold Laqua (sister), Amber Compton Engels (sister), and Lance Engels (nephew).
