Randy William Drews was born Christmas Day in 1957 to Lester and Evelyn (Magnuson) Drews. He grew up and attended school in Yutan, graduating from Yutan High School in 1976. He then earned his Associate's Degree in Diesel Mechanic from Southeast Community College in Milford, Nebraska in 1978. Growing up in Yutan, Randy spent most of his time helping on the family farm.

Randy married Dawn Strong on May 21, 1983 in Ralston, Nebraska, and they were blessed with one son, Justin. Randy and Dawn made their home just outside of Yutan.
