Randall Joshua Miller was born March 24, 1979 in Newark, Ohio. Randy grew up in Ohio, but moved to Valley, Nebraska when he was in the 8th grade. He attended school in Valley, and enjoyed camping, fishing, hanging with his friends, and cruising the backroads around town. But most of all, he both picked on and protected his sister, Amanda. Randy married Alexandria Dillon on October 18, 2006. He became Dad to her daughter, Natalie, and the couple welcomed three other children; Nathan, Madison and Korbin. His kids were the love of his life, and he would do anything for them.
