



## Richard Lee Geier

May 7, 1936 - December 18, 2025

Richard “Dick” Lee Geier, 89, of Elkhorn, Nebraska, passed away on December 18, 2025. He was born May 7, 1936, to Martin and Elizabeth Geier on the family farm near Culbertson, Nebraska.

Richard attended a country grade school and graduated from Culbertson High School in 1954. He married Marilyn Lenhart in 1959, and together they shared more than six decades of marriage. Two daughters were born to this union, Belinda and Alison.

Richard began his career as a bricklayer apprentice and later founded Geier Masonry in McCook, Nebraska, where he participated in numerous residential and commercial construction projects. In 1966, the family moved to Lincoln, Nebraska, where Richard and Marilyn owned and operated Geier’s Bottle Shop and later Accent by Richmar, a gift and flower shop. In 1973, Richard returned to the construction industry, where he spent the remainder of his career as a dedicated manufacturer’s representative for Yankee Hill Brick and Endicott Clay Products.

Richard was an avid fan of Husker football and volleyball, as well as Nebraska high school football. He also enjoyed sprint car racing and followed the World of Outlaws and High Limit racing series.

Richard was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, uncle, and friend. He will be remembered for his kindness, generosity, and willingness to help others without expectation. His legacy lives on through the lives he touched and the love he shared.

Survivors include his wife of 66 years, Marilyn Geier of Elkhorn; daughters, Belinda Geier of League City, Texas, and Alison (Aaron) Hunter of Gretna, Nebraska; granddaughter, Adriane Geier-Hunter (Bree) of Omaha, Nebraska; sister-in-law, Martha Jane (Jon) Power of Irvine, California; and many nieces, nephews, relatives, and friends.

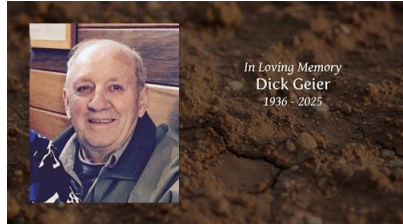

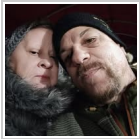
