



## Richard "Rick" Dean Lochmiller

January 30, 1950 - September 29, 2024

Richard "Rick" Dean Lochmiller was born in Denison, IA on January 30, 1950 to Drexel and Vera Lochmiller and went home to be with Jesus on September 29, 2024. The youngest of three siblings, he grew up in Spencer, Iowa and attended Spencer Public Schools where on graduation day, he met the love of his life, Margie Ann Mart. The two were married in 1970 and moved to Fort Campbell, KY when Rick enlisted in the Army. The two later moved to Nebraska where they laid roots in Valley and raised three children of their own, Nicole (Nicki Nicker Bobstein), Richard John (Trooper John), and Stephanie (Pee-wee). The family spent many happy years playing on the lake, learning to waterski and being involuntarily tossed from innertubes behind the boat.

Rick spent his career in various leadership and ownership roles within the mechanical engineering sector, but most enjoyed his time at the family home in Ginger Cove where he spent his final days surrounded by family.

When not working, he could be found tinkering in his garage, remodeling spaces for his children, taking things apart to simply put them back together again, or puttering around the lake in his boat. More recently he was joined on the boat by his second love, Jenna, a black rescue lab, who was by his side until the end.

Rick was preceded in death by his parents, Drexel and Vera Lochmiller. He is survived by his wife of 54 years, Marge Lochmiller, oldest daughter Nicole Hunter (Jason), his son, Rick Lochmiller (Jennifer) and youngest daughter,
