



Robert Lincoln Alderson

February 18, 1937 - March 21, 2026

Robert Lincoln Alderson of Omaha, Nebraska passed away at the age of 89 on March 21, 2026 at Hillcrest Millard. Robert was born in Pacific Junction, Iowa on February 18, 1937 to Pauline (Lincoln) Alderson and Oliver Dale Alderson. Bob had one sister, Dalene. He attended school in Humphrey through the grade school years. He always spent summer in Pacific Junction on the farm helping his grandparents. When he was a sophomore he transferred to the Glenwood schools. He graduated from Glenwood in 1955. His sport was basketball, but he also played football and track.

Bob met his wife, Shirley, in the summer of 1954. Bob and Shirley were married August 5, 1956 in Malvern and resided there for a year while Bob worked at the local newspaper office. He attended UNL for a year and then went to WSC and graduated in 1960 with a teaching degree. For the next few years he taught and coached in Oxford and DeWitt. He had the honor of his DeWitt team going to the state tournament. Their three children were born, Robb in Oxford, Jeff in Lincoln, and Vicki in Beatrice. Sadly, Vicki was lost to them in 2005 in a car accident. In 1966, they returned to his hometown, Humphrey, where he joined his family at the Farmer's State Bank. He also continued to coach basketball at Humphrey Saint Francis for three years. Bob was active in civic duties; for many years he was on the Humphrey High School Board. He actively followed his children in all their school activities, which were many. He enjoyed bowling, golfing, and in his younger years

hunting and fishing, but his favorite pastime was watching sports. He liked being outside doing yard work.

The family moved to Omaha in 1989 and bought convenience stores. After selling the convenience stores, Bob went back to substitute teaching, which he did for many years into his 80s. He was a family person, loved his children, grandchildren and the great grands!

Bob was preceded in death by his daughter, Vicki, and by his parents. He is survived by his wife, Shirley; his sons and their spouses, Robb and Diana Alderson of Elkhorn, and Jeff Alderson and Twila Flamme of North Bend; a special friend, Mark Flamme of Weatherford, TX; six grandchildren and their spouses, Robert and Liz Alderson of Omaha, Jonathan and Maggie Alderson of Omaha, Mary and Adam Heimes of Omaha, Collin and Kenzie Alderson of Elkhorn, NE, Olivia Flamme and Caleb Eichelberger of Iowa City, IA, and Allena and Joe Henderson of Shawnee, KS; great-grandchildren, Remi and Ryder; and his sister, Dalene Purchal, along with nieces and nephews. He is also survived by many other relatives and friends. He will be deeply missed.
