Robert L. "Bob" Belik was born July 21, 1943 in Omaha, Nebraska to Ernest and Rose (Chmelka) Belik. The family moved to Prague, Nebraska when Bob was two years old. He attended St. John's Parochial school, and graduated from Prague High School in 1961. While in school, Bob enjoyed track, basketball, and football.

On May 2, 1964, Bob married Rosann Veskrna at the Prague Presbyterian Church. They lived on a farm outside of Millard, Nebraska until 1975, when they moved to Yutan, Nebraska.
