They sold and serviced a wide variety of clientele until they both retired in 1979. Bob and Eileen not only worked everyday together they enjoyed each others company. They moved from Omaha to Elkhorn 32 years ago and enjoyed the small town atmosphere.

Bob’s hobbies were few, but his interest’s were large. He enjoyed the “Cottage” that he and Eileen built as an escape from the business. They enjoyed almost 40 years of just tinkering around at the river. Bob enjoyed Air
