Rod had a good sense of humor and was often heard asking, "What's on Your Shirt?" or saying, "Pull My Finger!" There were some traditions that Rod was sure to follow every year; he always sent his children a Valentine's gift, and every Christmas he watched A Christmas Story. When his children were little, he would hum "Over the Rainbow" to them as they fell asleep. Rod was a good man and provider to his family; he was sentimental, authentic, and inviting. He always took care of others and did it with a smile on his face. He was incredibly loving and truly enjoyed any time he was able to spend with his family.
