



Ronald Sovereign

August 5, 1939 - September 7, 2024

Ronald Sovereign was born in Norfolk, Nebraska on the south side of the tracks on Benjamin Avenue on August 5, 1939. He was the first born of Lloyd and Sylvia (Rakowsky) Sovereign and was followed by his three siblings: sister, Neoma, brother, Dan, and brother, Eugene "Joe". Ron was raised in Norfolk until the age of 15 when he left home to see the world. At age 17, he returned to Norfolk and joined the Navy. Ron served for 3 years, 10 months, 22 days, 16 hours, and 56 minutes before his honorable discharge, and he dearly loved every minute of it.

After his time in the military, Ron started work at the Chicago Northwestern railroad for a period of 25 years. He married Barbara Marie Tacey on February 23, 1963. This marriage lasted for nearly 50 years; they were just 23 days short of their anniversary when Barbara passed. Barbara gave Ron one son, Anthony Raymond Sovereign on June 2, 1964. Tony then gave Ron one granddaughter, Hollyann and one grandson, Tanner which could not have happened without his loving wife, Julie.

A visitation will be held from 5-7pm on Tuesday, September 10, 2024 at Reichmuth Funeral Home with a Wake Service beginning at 7pm.
