Rose May (Marie) King Carson was born on August 4, 1932 in Howards Mill, Kentucky to John and Grace (Mounts) King. She grew up in Middletown, Ohio where she attended grade school and graduated from Middletown High School in 1950. As a young girl, Rose grew up on the family farm, where from an early age she learned to love the outdoors and spent endless hours helping her father with the chores.
