



## Rosemarie Myers Jones

November 28, 1925 - October 6, 2009

Rosemarie Myers Jones was born November 28, 1925 in Omaha, Nebraska to Charles Andrew and Georgia Helen Virginia (Wilcox) Myers. Rosemarie grew up in South Omaha and graduated from Omaha South High School in 1942. She was athletic and adventurous from a young age, and took part in gymnastics.

Rosemarie married Robert J. Jones on October 7, 1945 in Sydney, Iowa, and to this union, two sons were born: Dana and Scott. The family made their home in Omaha until moving to Elkhorn in 1975.

“Mike” as Rosemarie was most often known as, worked for Wilson Packing as a billing clerk from 1943 until 1945. She then worked for a time at Nelson News while Robert was overseas in the military.

In her prime, Rosemarie was an avid gardener and a gifted, self-taught artist, duplicating animal greeting cards. She was also a glassware enthusiast, oftentimes being asked to value glassware for other people. Rosemarie enjoyed finding treasures at garage sales, too. She was especially proud of her American lineage, which traces back to the American Revolution, where an ancestor was a dispatch rider between General Washington’s forces and Rochambeau, who led the French.

She was a woman who was happiest being around people, but most

cherished being a wife, mother, grandmother, and great grandmother to her family. Rosemarie is finally free from this earth and all its laws and restrictions.

Rosemarie passed away in her sleep on October 6, 2009 at her home in Elkhorn, Nebraska at the age of 83 years, 10 months, and 8 days, one day short of her 64th wedding anniversary. She is preceded in death by her parents, Charles and Georgia Myers, and sisters: Babe Miller, Mildred Roubicek, and Cleo Schmidtke. Rosemarie is survived by her husband Robert J. Jones of Elkhorn, sons and daughters-in-law: Dana and Kathleen Jones of Santa Cruz, California, and Scott and Floy Jones of Elkhorn, granddaughter Kyle and husband John Flocht of Council Bluffs, Iowa, grandson Reagan Jones of Elkhorn, 2 great granddaughters and a host of nieces, nephews, and friends.
