“ *I met Ruth back in the early 70's when I worked in Respiratory Therapy at the VA Medical Center. My co-worker was George Clark-thus, between him and working in the Intensive Care Unit, I got to meet Ruth. She could be very tough at times and her dry sense of humor took my awhile to figure her out. She was an excellent nurse and took pride in her work. Many a time, I would hear the stories of the parties she and George would have after work (they worked the 3-11 shift) until the wee hours of the morning. They were one of the first people any of us knew who had an "automatic ice maker" - years later, Ruth told me it was all George's doing, he insisted on having that feature. I left the VA in 1989. Then, in January 2016, I ran into Ruth again as I was starting up my Cardiac Rehab at Lakeside and she volunteered on Wednesdays. It was like old times again and we talked and laughed-she shared her stories of her family, her travels and we rehashed our VA days. I was so sad when I heard of her passing-my deepest condolences to her family and know that you are all in my thoughts and prayers , as is Ruth.*
