Sandy was born November 20, 1944 and grew up in central Mississippi, graduating from Kosciusko Senior High School in 1962. She met Luke Aldy (L.M.) in 1961 and they married shortly thereafter in November 1962. They began their life together in Birmingham, Alabama, where Matt was born in 1964. They moved to Atlanta, Georgia, where Amy was born in 1968. Sandy and Luke moved to Omaha, Nebraska in November 1973 and celebrated their 58th wedding anniversary this past year.
