Scott Francis Wallace was born August 8, 1961 in Omaha, Nebraska to Thomas J. and Anne L. (Brodecky) Wallace. Scott grew up in Omaha where he attended grade school at St. James Catholic, and graduated from Creighton Prep High School in 1979. After high school, Scott attended the University of Nebraska in Lincoln.

Affectionately known by family and friends as “Wally” or “Bro”, Scott has made his home in Omaha, and is the proud father of Kurt, Brent, and Kaylee Wallace, and Jennifer and Ashley Brown, and Grandpa to Tatum Hanken. Scott was engaged to be married to the love of his life, Bonita Smith, this August 9, 2012.

Scott worked as a pipe fabricator for Midwest Pipe and most recently, was the owner of Foundry Services. He was active with his church group at Calvary Chapel, but Scott most loved being active and being outdoors.
