Susan Kay MacKenzie , 75, passed away peacefully on July 23rd, 2024.

If there was a song to be sung, Sue's was the first voice you'd hear. She spent much time supporting her kids, grandkids, nieces, and nephews in their various activities and was in the stands cheering whenever she could make it. She loved the Nebraska Cornhuskers and supported them in the best and worst of seasons. Her boundless positive spirit and energy has been greatly missed in her final years, in many ways stolen by her struggle with Alzheimer's, but her family and friends will remember it fondly and loved

her to the moon and back.

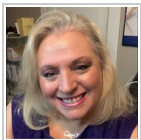
