Terry Clarence Lewis was born on September 24, 1938 in Omaha NE to Clarence and Iona (Grebe) Lewis. Terry attended District 22 grade school and Valley High School where he participated in sports, student government and plays, graduating in 1956.

Terry met Roxie Winkler through friends in Valley in 1960. They were married on April 28, 1962 and were blessed with two children: Thomas and Ryan. They first lived in Valley, then built a home on the Lewis family farm where they raised their sons, and then built another home in Elkhorn when Terry retired. Terry was blessed with three grandchildren, whom he adored: Jacob, Morgan and Tyler.

Terry worked for Northern Natural Gas, then farmed for years with his father and retired from the US Postal Service in 2001. Terry and Roxie worked hard and were proud to provide for their sons' educations. He was in the Army Reserves for 6 years, served on agricultural boards, and the Valley school board. He was an avid sports fan and enjoyed going to Husker games, bowling and playing softball. He enjoyed frequent trips to Kansas City and Chicago for professional baseball games.

Terry was received into the Catholic Church on June 17, 2013.

Terry died on September 16, 2013 at the Josie Harper Hospice House in Omaha after a six and a half year battle with cancer, at the age of 74 years, 11 months, and 23 days. He was preceded in death by his parents. He is survived by his wife of 51 years, Roxie of Elkhorn, son and daughter-in-law Dr.

Thomas and Tonya of Elkhorn, son Fr. Ryan of Omaha; grandchildren Jacob, Morgan and Tyler; brother and sister-in-law John and Kathleen, and many other relatives and friends. Terry will be missed by all who knew and loved him.
