Vicki has always been a hard worker, having many jobs including Jetto Space, Bellevue Products, International Radio, Home Day Care, Pendleton Mills, Qualex, Majors Plastics and Streck Manufacturing. She was especially talented with crafts, spending many years creating shadowboxes and enjoying weekend adventures at craft shows across the midwest. She collected anything to do with Mickey Mouse and enjoyed watching news and crime shows, playing Yahtzee, and family trips to Virginia and Branson. Vicki loved to listen to the singer Joseph Hall and made regular trips to Lake Manawa to watch the deer and ducks. She was a loving, lucky, giving and strong-willed woman who treasured her time with her family. Vicki enjoyed old time rock and roll, dinner at Howard's and special time with her grandchildren. Her son, Bryan, took great pleasure in teasing his mother, including the time he

surprised Vicki while the family was having a dinner at Howard's and Bryan, dressed as Santa Claus made quite a pest of himself before Vicki realized it was him, all the way from Virginia. She will be forever remembered for her signature saying, "Same Difference".
