Vicki has worked in various areas of the medical field with time off for raising her sons. She enjoyed baseball, scrapbooking, crochet and spending time with her grandchildren. Vicki was a strong willed woman who “ruled the roost”. She was dedicated to her family and treasured the time they spent together.
