Viola Katherine Witte nee Ohm was born to George and Mary Ohm on June 13th, 1913. She spent most of her childhood in and around Yutan, Nebraska, and attended school in the District 8 School. On January 16th, 1935 she was united in marriage to Elmer Witte. After their marriage they lived on a farm southwest of Yutan until 1942. That is when the Nebraska Ordnance plant took many acres of farmland that included the farm where they were living. They got their notice to move by February 10th, 1942, and they moved to a farm seven miles south of Fremont, Nebraska, and continued to farm there until their retirement in 1979. A home was purchased in Yutan where they lived for eleven years. After Elmer passed away Viola resided in their home until 1992 when she sold her home and moved to WestView Apartments in Wahoo, Nebraska, and lived there a short time. She later moved to Saunders House and the next move was made to Haven House in Wahoo, Nebraska.

Viola passed away on Monday, September 17, 2007 at the Wahoo Care Center in Wahoo, Nebraska at the age of 94 years, 3 months and 4 days. She was preceded in death by her husband Elmer who passed away on April 21, 1991; her parents George and Mary Ohm and by four brothers: Herman, Edgar, Benjamin and Henry Ohm. Viola is survived by two sisters: Rosella Snelling of Wahoo, Nebraska, and Irene Purcell of Rocklin, California and a brother Edward Ohm and wife Leola of Elkhorn Nebraska; also by a sister-in-law Alberta Ohm of Mesa, Arizona and by nieces and nephews.

Viola will be remembered fondly by all who knew her. She loved music and dancing and was known for making the best buns and cinnamon rolls. Her pantry was always ready for guests. She was a great babysitter and much loved by her nieces and nephews.
