William Stephen Bosanek was born on October 24, 1943 in Omaha, Nebraska to Charles and Frances (Pavlick) Bosanek. He grew up in South Omaha where he attended St. Peter and Paul Catholic grade school and graduated from Omaha Pratt High School in 1961. As a young boy, Bill's life revolved around family especially time with his father. He was active in the Papillion Saddle Club as a young adult.
