Willis August Witt was born February 8, 1915 on a farm in Bonesteel, South Dakota. Willis was the fifth child born to Gustav and Wilhelmina (Dummer) Witt. He was baptized and confirmed into the Lutheran faith Missouri Synod in Fairfax, South Dakota. Willis attended a country school in Bonesteel until the 8th grade.

He moved to Omaha in 1936 and married Loretta Neuhaus on December 3, 1936 at Immanuel Lutheran Church. To his union three sons were born: Willis G., Malvin R. and Donald W. He lived on the farm until 1991 and then moved to 14329 Military Road. He moved to Remington Heights in September of 2004 and then to Marquis Place in October of 2008. He has been a member of Zion Lutheran Church since 1937 and has served as an elder, an usher and on the planning board. Willis farmed all of his life, sold Farmer's Seed corn for many years and was a long time Farm Bureau member. He loved his family and was always joking around and had a great sense of humor.

Willis passed away on Friday, April 3, 2009 at the Lakeside Hospital in Omaha, Nebraska at the age of 94 years, one month and 26 days. He was preceded in death by his wives Loretta in 1971, Alice in 1985 and Louise in 1992, brothers Herman, Walter, Lawrence, Raymond, and Glenn, sisters Elsie Neuhaus and Gladys Preuss Knowles. Willis is survived by his sons and daughters-in-law Willis G. and Kathy of Omaha, Nebraska, Malvin and Elaine
